But then he befriends a mysterious neighbor, Old Zeb, a grizzled sailor who builds ships in bottles. Walter works faithfully on Zeb's Great Secret Project and lifelong dream, and little by little Old Zeb helps Walter realize his own dreams." Ask students to include in the story what they think Old Zeb's secret project and lifelong dream is and what Walter's dream is.
